Save the Corals

OUR TARGET:

Coral reefs are vital for marine life, as well as for tourism, fishing, and local communities. Coral reefs are disappearing due to pollution, global warming, and water acidification. Our goal is to rebuild, monitor, and protect local coral reefs.

You can support us by sponsoring a Coral Sanctuary. This is a concrete structure of between 400-450kg that is constructed underwater and is designed for the natural settlement of approximately 100 corals.

Save the Sharks

OUR TARGET:

The Galapagos Marine Reserve (GMR) is one of the most productive ocean areas on this planet, including one of the highest concentrations of sharks found globally, and the largest aggregation of mature female whale sharks known to science. But this marine life is endangered for many reasons, including over-intensive fishing outside of the Galapagos Marine Reserve.

Together we can cover the cost of one satellite tracker for a shark.

This is crucial for mapping habitats and recording strong evidence in order to enhance ocean conservation efforts.



Save the Penguins

OUR TARGET:

Penguins are birds that have lost the ability to fly, but on the other hand, are excellent swimmers. Their role in the marine ecosystem is fundamental as they are predators.

Save the Whales

OUR TARGET:

Traditionally, whaling and bycatch were seen as the main threats to marine mammals. However, recent studies have identified that collisions between Marine Mammals and ships, known as "ship strikes", are now considered to be one of the primary threats.

These collisions, often unnoticed and underreported, are termed the "silent massacre". With only about 10% of affected whales washing ashore, the true extent remains underestimated. Friend of the Sea is working to raise awareness and minimize this impact.

Save the Dolphins

OUR TARGET:

The Franciscana dolphin (*Pontoporia blainvillei*) stands out as the most threatened coastal dolphin in the South Atlantic Ocean, being classified as "vulnerable" by the IUCN Red List. It faces significant threats due to habitat overlap with fishing and marine degradation.

To address this, our project uses passive acoustic monitoring, like C-PODs, to pinpoint their active areas. We aim to understand their habitat and population status. Alongside scientific research, we'll share informative posts on LEC/UFPR and Associação MarBrasil's Instagram.

These will cover the dolphins' traits, behavior, threats they face, aiming to raise awareness, educate a wider audience about the conservation of this species, and garner support for their conservation.

Save the Butterflies

OUR TARGET:

Butterflies and moths are colorful, harmless insects that populate much of our world with more than 178,000 species. Besides their fundamental role as pollinators, they are also a source of food for numerous other species. Here their importance in terms of biodiversity is extremely high.

To protect these insects, we have developed a Global Butterfly Census project. In addition, we can restore degraded areas (where butterflies can proliferate), create butterfly houses, and raise public awareness.

Save the Primates

OUR TARGET:

The singing lemurs (*Indri indri*) live in the Maromizaha, Madagascar rain forest.

Singing lemurs are the only lemurs to communicate through actual singing, which echoes in the forests of Madagascar. This lemur is critically endangered and therefore must be protected in its natural habitat, which however, due to deforestation, is being threatened.

We therefore ask you to **support us to help continue to protect and expand Indri's habitat, through a reforestation project** consisting of 5 hectares and 10.000 plants, by involving local communities and schoolchildren in Maromizaha, Madagascar.

Save the Pangolins

OUR TARGET:

Pangolins are threatened animals. We would like to focus on providing support to SVW's rescue and rehabilitation facilities in Cuc Phuong National Park, where pangolins are fed and cared for daily. Since many of their animals come to them with significant injuries, diseases, and illnesses to treat, it is essential to maintain clean, new, and hygienic conditions with quarantine facilities as well as large and lively enclosures with enrichment for the animals to readjust to wild behavior prior to being released back into the wild.

SVW would like to request support for the rescue and rehabilitation center's facility maintenance which would include the following:

- Purchase of working tools and supplies for the captive team.
- Develop environmental enrichment tools and supplies for the animals.

Save the Rhinos

OUR TARGET:

Winter 2021 saw the arrival of a five-week-old rhino baby and her mother at the Rhino Orphanage. The baby had been attacked by 12 lions and although her mother saved her from certain death, one of the lions bit Impi across the stifle joint of her right back leg.

At first, it seemed that there was only soft tissue damage, but in a few months, it was evident that the damage to the condyle of her femur was substantial. Impi's rehabilitation will last several years as her veterinary team needs to do corrective surgery and a possible knee replacement when she is old enough. She will therefore remain under our care for at least the next 5 years, with costs for veterinary treatment, surgeries and specialists, food, and security added to our overheads.

Save the Snails

OUR TARGET:

Melanopsis etrusca is a freshwater gastropod endemic to southern Tuscany. The species is in decline. Among the main causes, there has been documented overexploitation of thermal springs for wellness uses in combination with water drainage and contamination caused by agricultural and mining activities.

An additional threat to populations is habitat destruction due to urban development and the introduction of non-native aquatic fauna.

Our goal is to reintroduce specimens of this gastropod into the wild.
